1. What impacted you the most in this episode, and why?
2. Why were the children drawn to Jesus? What stood out to you about how Jesus interacted with the children?
3. In Matthew 18:3 Jesus says, "Unless you become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven." And in this episode Jesus is quoted as saying, "Many times adults need the faith of children." What do you think this means, and how does that apply to you and us all?
4. Think about the tenderness of Jesus toward these children. What does it do to your faith and thinking to believe that Jesus has this same tenderness toward you?
5. The Bible makes clear that Jesus is fully God and fully human. What did this episode reveal about Jesus as the Son of Man? What are some of the depictions of Jesus in this episode that drive home the humanity of Jesus? God became like us in every way. How does it make you feel that Jesus experienced real life on the earth, with all its challenges?
6. What did this episode show about Jesus' attitude toward work?
7. One of the quotes has Jesus saying, "Everyone has a much larger job than just their trade." What do you think he was referring to?
8. Another quote of Jesus in this episode was, "What is my reason for being here? The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD." He was quoting Isaiah 61. How does Jesus' ministry apply to you?
