

## The Chosen - Season 1, Ep. 5: 'The Wedding Gift' - Discussion & Study

1. What stood out to you or impacted you the most in this episode?
2. Did you identify with any of the characters in this story? Which one, and why?
3. What did you like most about how Jesus was portrayed in this episode? Why?
4. Jesus tells Thomas to fill the jars with water up to the brim. Thomas says, "From the directions you have provided I see no logical solution to the problem." Jesus says, "It's going to be like that sometimes Thomas." And then Jesus says, "Join Me & I will show you a new way to count & measure, a different way of seeing time? What do you think Jesus meant? Why did Jesus not rebuke Thomas when he didn't understand what Jesus was doing?"
5. What is the significance of Jesus turning water into wine? How is it a "sign?" Why do you think Jesus performed the miracle?
6. In the conversation of the disciples at the wedding feast, Peter says, "I do not know why He picked me" and he dismisses himself as unqualified to follow Jesus. How have you been like Peter in this scene? If so, explain.
7. Consider the words of Jesus from John 15:16 – "You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you." What is your reaction to this? Read the account in Scripture: John 2:1-11 (Jesus turning the water into wine)
