3. What is the significance of the opening scene of Moses and Joshua, and the bronze serpent?  
Read Numbers 21:4-9, Proverbs 3:5
4. There is a crisis of reason and logic versus faith and trust in this episode. Where do you find yourself in this spectrum, especially related to areas in your life right now? Is it easy for you to step out in something He is telling you to do without question?
5. What struck you most about the rooftop meeting between Jesus and Nicodemus? How is the way Jesus treated & related to Nicodemus in this scene different than what you envisioned when you read this story in the Bible?
6. What made Matthew say yes to Jesus? What made Nicodemus hesitate to accept Jesus' invitation to "follow Me?"
7. How did you come to a point in your life when you were convinced that you wanted to be a follower of Jesus? Would you be willing to share it with your group? Read these Scriptural accounts:  
John 3:1-21 (Jesus' encounter with Nicodemus);  
Matthew 9:9-13 (Jesus calls Matthew);  
Numbers 21:4-9 (Moses and the bronze serpent).
